Overview

Common Question from our Customers:

I can't select any attributes. I don't see the check marks to select the attributes. Any ideas?

Answer

Yes. You have your screen fonts set at *more* than 100% e.g. 125, 150+ percent. If you are using <u>Windows 10</u> this issue has automatically been fixed in that OS.



<u>Steps</u>

If you are using **Windows 7**:

Right-mouse click anywhere on your Desktop.



Right-click on the desktop



Select Personalize.

In the Search box, type: 'font size'





In the search results, click: Make text and other items large or smaller

Set the radio button for 100%

Tip: If you like your computer resolution to run at **125+ percent**, create <u>multiple user accounts</u> for that machine, one that runs on 100% for **Trail Blazer** work, and another one with the higher resolution/font-size so that you can switch back and forth as necessary.
