## Overview

### **Common Question from our Customers:**

I can't select any attributes. I don't see the check marks to select the attributes. Any ideas?

### **Answer**

Yes. You have your screen fonts set at *more* than 100% e.g. 125, 150+ percent. **If you are using [Windows 10](#) this issue has automatically been fixed in that OS.**


## Steps

If you are using **Windows 7**:

Right-mouse click anywhere on your Desktop.


## Right-click on the desktop



Select **Personalize**.

In the Search box, type: **'font size'**



In the search results, click: **Make text and other items large or smaller**

Set the radio button for **100%**

 **Tip:** If you like your computer resolution to run at **125+ percent**, create [multiple user accounts](#) for that machine, one that runs on 100% for **TrailBlazer** work, and another one with the higher resolution/font-size so that you can switch back and forth as necessary.

## Steps to Change DPI on *Other* Versions of Windows

- **XP**
  - o Follow this path to get started: **Start ► Control Panel ► Appearance and Themes ► Display**
  - o Open the **Settings** tab and then click on **Advanced**
  - o On the **General** tab you will find the **DPI setting** list
    - § Set DPI to 100%
    - § Restart your computer if necessary
- **Vista**
  - o Follow this path to get started: **Start ► Control Panel ► Appearance and Personalization ► Personalization**
  - o In the left pane click on **Adjust font size (DPI)**
    - § Set DPI to 100%
    - § Restart your computer if necessary
- **7**
  - o Follow this path to get started: **Start ► Control Panel ► Appearance and Personalization**
  - o Under the **Display** heading click **Make Text And Other Items Larger Or Smaller**
    - § Set to 100%

§ Restart your computer if necessary

### 8 and 8.1

- o Follow this path to get started: **Start ► Control Panel ► Display**
  - o Adjust the slider under **Change the size of all items** to 100%
- § Restart your computer if necessary
